The Texas Public Information Act ("TPIA") is the vehicle through which members of the public and media access information in the hands of governmental bodies in Texas. State and local governments are the repository of a wide variety of information, and requests for copies of or access to that information are ever increasing. Whether a particular item of information can, may, or must be released or withheld can sometimes vary depending on the circumstances, and there are a myriad of rules, exceptions, presumptions and timelines which may apply. TPIA also contains civil and criminal penalties for violation of its provisions, so it is important that the officials responsible for processing of public information requests be familiar with the applicable TPIA provisions. This seminar is designed to provide instruction to law enforcement and administrative personnel on the operative provisions and requirements of TPIA, as well as practical guidance on how to prepare responses to frequently requested information, including the preparation of requests for open records opinions of the Texas Attorney General.
